

# Moseley in Bloom Open Gardens Weekend 2009 Gardens Opening

# Saturday 20th June 2009 North Moseley & Moseley Triangle

## Flat 1, 11 Oakland Road – 1

During the past two years this garden has been transformed from a wilderness to a vibrant organically managed space where flowers, fruiting trees and vegetables mingle everywhere one looks.



## The Coach House, Oakland Road – 2

Over the last 10 years this delightful garden has evolved from a building site into a tranquil colourful oasis. To take advantage of the sun through the day it sports two essential sybaritic spaces for sitting and supping!



## 20 Mayfield Road – 3

Fairly new garden of two parts, the first having a real Mediterranean feel, and the second a surprise contemporary twist. Post-tornado birch grove, lovely planting for both sun and shade and amazingly a family garden that is also very grown-up. Design by Glenn Fraser.



## 22 Mayfield Road – 4

Fabulously idiosyncratic garden of foliage and form. Intriguing architectural set pieces and hidden seating make this garden truly unmissable. Beware uneven paths and precipitous drops!



## 11 Merton Road – 5

A charming combination of patio gardening, wide perennial borders around a well tended lawn, raised vegetable beds and fruit trees. It's all here!



## 23 Merton Road – 6

A paved flowerpot strewn patio with a pond leads the eye towards the wide flat lawn of a deceptively large and varied garden. Deep mixed borders, a woodland walk beyond which the garden becomes a 'T' shape. Something here for every type of gardener, and watch out for the chickens!



## Tennis Club, Billesley Lane – 7

The newly planted orchard, now in its second year, is a tranquil area behind the activity on the courts. Rescued from a seething wilderness the possibilities are there for every organic fruit eater!



## 49 Greenhill Road – 8

A verdant, sculptural garden with a continental feel. Elegant mature shrubs and trees, of varying height, colour and texture give way to a meadow with summer house and herb garden.



## 51 Greenhill Road – 9

Long garden of rooms with a real country feel evocative of the 1930s. Traditional lawned area with mature borders, vegetable garden and wildflower meadow with orchard.



## 12 Southlands Road – 10

A developing small cottage garden with a pond and a wealth of annuals, perennials and climbers mixed in with vegetables and fruit.



## 11 Southlands Road – 11

A last minute but very welcome addition! A garden cascading down from the house and built on two levels with wonderful views across the allotments.



## Billesley Lane Allotments - 12

Traditional allotments in a beautiful old setting, recently sadly downsized but still a gem and today holding their 2009 Open Day



## 15 Thornley Close (off Cambridge Rd) – 13

A small garden, modernistic in design. Now maturing into a very elegant and beautiful environment. (Access to patio level, series of steps to main garden) – Please park on Cambridge Road.



## 73 Cambridge Road – 14

Two for the price of one. The front garden was reclaimed from tarmac and manhole covers to make a much more environmentally friendly garden. The back garden is a tiny North-facing garden. Narrow bridge, deep water, lots and lots of plants.



## 77 Cambridge Road – 15

A front garden only. Another example of how to get the best of combining cars and garden and involves planting to survive a very windy corner.



## 5 Cambridge Road – 16

A large garden with wide lawns, mature borders but lots of new planting to enjoy. A rocky made from reclaimed stone. Greenhouse, fruit and veg areas and a Boules pit for those relaxing warm sunny days.



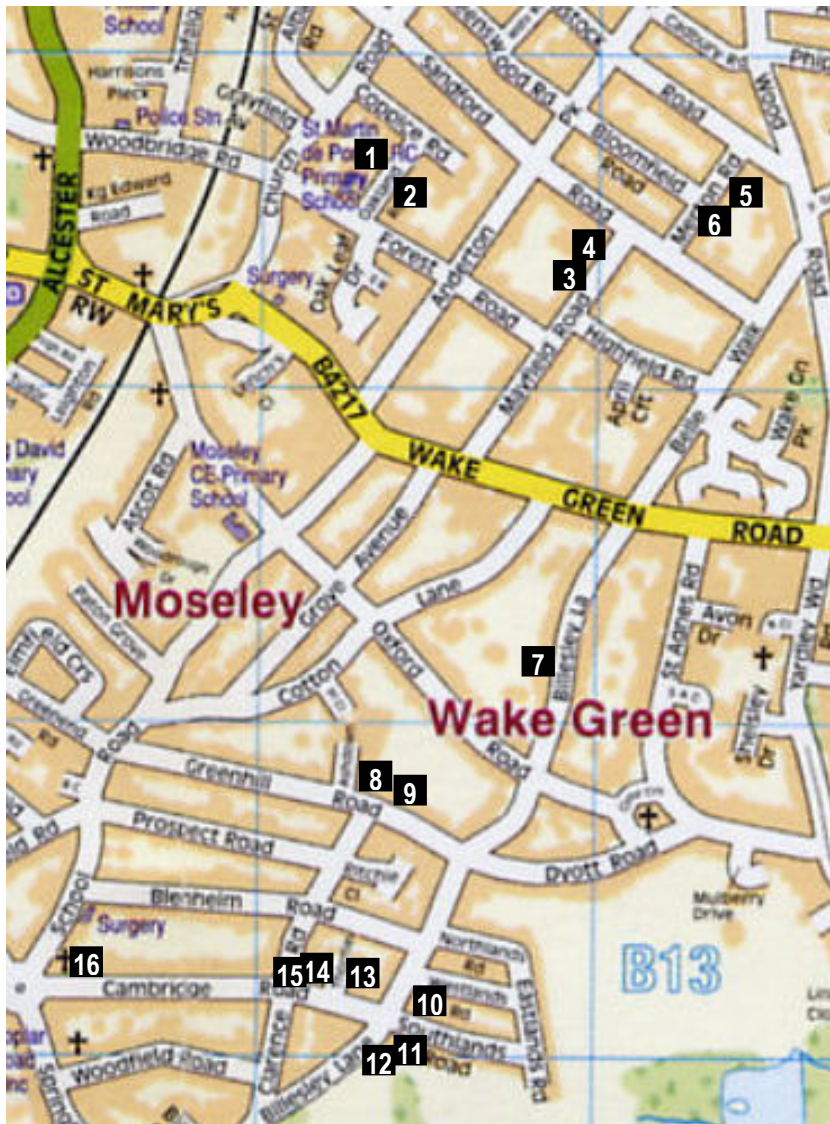
